

Konstantinos Papageorgiou is Managing Director and co-owner of PTL company, PhD candidate at the University of Piraeus and has been assigned by a Ministerial Decree as Member of the National Logistics Council since 2020, an advisory body to the Ministry of Development and to the Ministry of Infrastructure & Transport.

He has also broadened his knowledge of supply chain and business development by studying at Cambridge and Yale universities.

In 2021 he was also elected Member of the Board of the Hellenic Logistics Association (EEL), for a two years term of office.

He was awarded as one of the “Top Road Transport Managers” of the world in 2020, by the International Road Transport Organisation, IRU.

His company (PTL ) in 2016 and 2022 calculated its CO2 emissions and this proved to be the first step of its ongoing effort to develop more resilient, efficient and “greener” supply chain practices, to align with the transition to a low carbon economy. Later on, it also became one of the first companies in Greece to use alternative fuels (CNG).

In 2019, PTL was the first Greek haulage company to receive a “Sustainability Award” by the Bravo initiative. Konstantinos Papageorgiou stated that as global sustainability is evolving, he will be constantly looking for additional ways to support PTL in future-proofing its supply chain.
